1. The Iota Alumni Association organized and presented a Ritual workshop and roundtable discussion for the active members of the Iota chapter of Kappa Kappa Psi. Rather than holding a clinic on how to conduct them, the focus of the workshop was the significance and meaning of the rituals. Approximately 20 active brothers and 5 alumni members engaged in a rewarding and informative exchange. We have been invited to continue these efforts.
2. Efforts to track down all of the Alumni Brothers of the Iota Chapter of Kappa Kappa Psi continued. To date we have located more than 80% of our initiates.
3. While not necessarily an activity, the Iota Alumni Association plans to assist our local chapter in its goal to commission a piece for the 100th anniversary of the band program at the Georgia Institute of Technology in 2008.
4. A long-term activity involves the establishment of a scholarship for members of the Iota chapter. While the particulars will be debated for the foreseeable future, the first financial steps have been taken. We look forward to the opportunity to help promote music through assisting active and committed brothers continue and complete their scholastic endeavors while contributing bountifully to their fellows.
